

One Day Sound Editing Workshop by Dr. Mangesh Karandikar

The Department of Mass Media of SIES College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Sion (W), (Autonomous) conducted a virtual One Day Sound Editing Workshop on 27th March 2021 for the students of FY, SY, and TYBAMMC. The workshop was headed by Dr. Mangesh Karandikar. The workshop introduced newcomers to various sound editing software, how to record and filter sounds, and add various effects to ordinary sounds to enhance their quality.

Dr. Karandikar began the session by introducing commonly used sound editing software like Audacity. He then asked students to download the free software to work alongside in real-time. With a bunch of interactive tasks, he began editing down a raw audio file into a finished piece before the student's eyes and encouraged them to do the same. The students were left amazed at how easy and professional yet fast the process was to edit sound.

The session ended on a light yet informative note of recollecting what techniques and industry terms students had learned. From learning what pitch and bass mean, to adding echoes and reverbs and stereophonic sound, it's safe to say the students were left thoroughly excited to try their hands at sound editing.
