Students of M.Sc Part I enrolled in our college in the last academic year 2021-2022 for the subjects such as Bioanalytical Sciences / Biochemistry / Biotechnology / Botany / Chemistry / Computer Science / Data Science / Information Technology / Microbiology / Physics / Zoology, are hereby informed that the admissions for M.Sc Part II will be held from 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022 as per the following procedure:

- a) Student will carry college identity card along with a photocopy/xerox of the identity card and visit the respective department in college between 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022 (Timings: 10.30 am to 1 pm).
- b) Student will meet the head/coordinator/faculty from their respective department.
- c) Student will be provided in the respective department an Admission Form (student will not pay any fee for this admission form), which the student is required to fill with the essential details including specialization at M.Sc Part II (wherever applicable as per the subject).
- d) Student will attach the photocopy/xerox of identity card to the above Admission Form.
- e) Student will secure admission by payment of fees by submitting a Demand Draft as per the fee structure in following tables:
