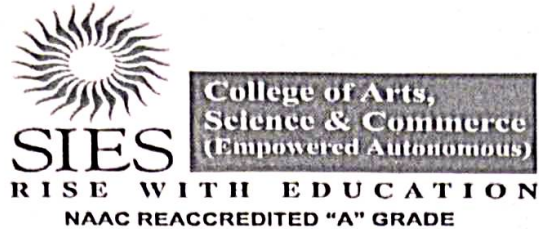

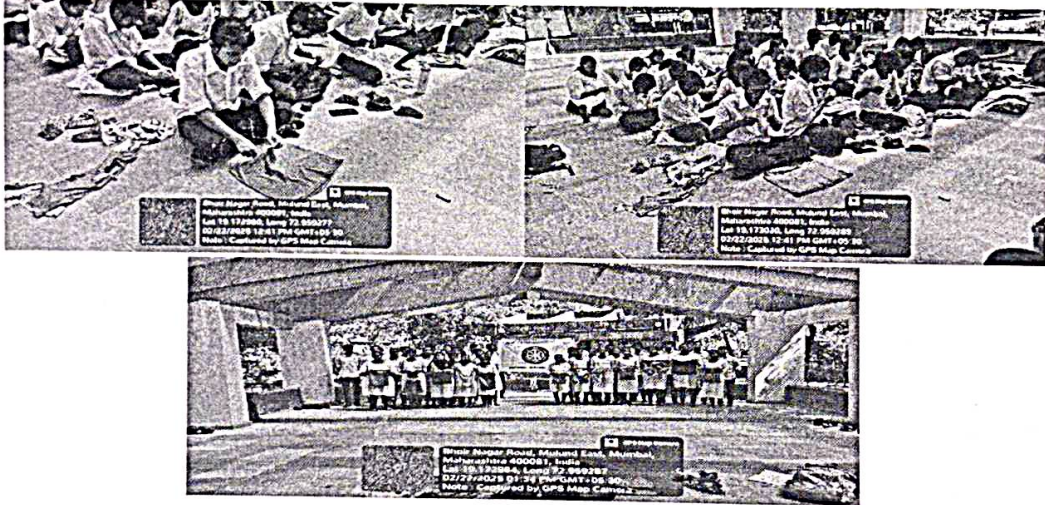

- H. Outcome/Feedback:** The NSS volunteers actively participated in a project to reduce plastic pollution by making eco-friendly cloth bags from old clothes. They collected waste cloths from local people, sorted them, and then stitched the pieces together to create reusable bags. The volunteers, both skilled and new to sewing, worked together to complete the bags. Once finished, the bags were distributed to 37 local shopkeepers as an alternative to plastic bags, helping to reduce plastic waste in the community.
