

To celebrate the Diamond Jubilee Year (1960 – 2020) of SIES College of Arts, Science & Commerce (Autonomous), Centre for Excellence joined hands with TRIZ Association of Asia as an Academic Partner to support the International Conference "TRIZ for X 2020", a one-week Research based Faculty Development Training Program which was held between 23rd and 27th November 2020. The participants were given online LMS login to view the lecture series online for a month and submit the review and feedback of each modules as a mark of the FDP completion.

International speakers and mentors from TRIZ held this Master class. The live conference content included TRIZ Experts talking on what's the latest thinking of TRIZ with its application to innovation. The topics covered two broad themes critical to meet the Covid challenge, namely: WHAT are the challenges which need to be addressed to enhance the value proposition of the organization? And HOW should these challenges be met with the least organizational Cost?

14 International speakers from various organization and companies were part of the International Conference TRIZ for X 2020. A total of 8 faculties from SIES institution took up this FDP certification along with 130 other international conference attendees.

Date: 16th November to 24th December 2019

Objectives:

1. Identify the core skills associated with reasoning & critical thinking.

Clarify the difference in cognition, reasoning and logic from a disciplinary perspective.

2. Apply Critical Thinking in practical situations.

Resource Person: Mr. Peter Akbar, Founder and Chief Instructor at Logos Inc.

Participants: 16

Methodology:

30 hours workshop included modules such as First Order and Second Order Thinking, Barriers to Critical Thinking, Decision Making, Creative Thinking and exercises designed to self-assess one's thoughts and change them with a logical approach. With every module, students were given various exercises and tests for evaluation. These tests consisted of solving problems at the end of the sessions or an objective test at the end of few modules. Along with the course the students were made to read select articles for class room discussion on "Art of Thinking Clearly".

Outcome:

The participants got to-

- Understand the significance of critical thinking in an inter-disciplinary context.
 - Explain the importance of bias in critical thinking and facilitated them to express.
 - Discuss relevant aspects of their life with real life situations.
