### REPORT:

Project title - P se Paathshala: Educational Program for Juvenile Kids of Umerkhadi Date - 1st July 2019 to 1st July 2020

Background - P se Paathshala was a year-long project organized collaboratively by the Rotary Club of Bombay Pier and Innewheel Club of Bombay Pier.
