


#### Value Lab

## REPORT OF ISR ACTIVITY OF DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

- A. Title of the activity: Fund-raising event for Army Connect project of SIES management
- B. Background: SIES management initiated the Project Army Connect to help Army Public School, Kamptee in Nagpur district. The goal was to raise funds through the donations of past and current students and staff members of SIES institutes so as to help to make Army Public Schools technologically advanced.
- C. Aims/Objectives: Department of Psychology organized a fair in college to raise funds for the above-mentioned cause.
- D. Location: Quadrangle, SIES College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous)
- E. Target audience/participants with number: 30 TYBA students organized this event and approximately 180 students and 15 staff members visited the fund-raising fair
- F. Details of the event: The event was based on the Hierarchy of Needs given by a psychologist- Abraham Maslow. There were various stalls corresponding to different levels of the needs in the Maslow's Hierarchy. There were food stalls of Chinese bhel, ice tea, chocolates etc. There was a stall of book marks, stickers and paintings too. All the food items and stickers were made by the TYBA Psychology students and they were sold at very reasonable rates. Apart from this there were stalls of interesting games, plants, pre-loved artificial jewelllery items, stationery items too. Staff members of the college as well as the Principal donated a lot of self-help books, novels, books on spirituality, politics etc., which were sold at a very low cost.
- G. Outcome: Rs. 22,045/- were gathered in this fair.

We met the students and checked their progress during our visit to Palghar. Every month a salary of 3300 Rs was credited to the teacher educating them. A total of 19,800 has been contributed with the help of sponsors. The salary up to the month of June has been paid and we will continue the initiative in next academic year as well.

Through the Friday-to-Friday lessons we aimed to empower and equip our interactors with essential language skills and effective communication techniques. A session was held every Friday as per the school's convenience. Recognizing the significance of these skills in their academic journey and future endeavours, the project aimed to provide a structured platform for learning and development. By focusing on grammar, vocabulary, formal communication, confident speaking, and punctuation, the initiative sought to instill a strong foundation in language proficiency. The intention was to enhance the student's confidence, articulation, and overall communication abilities, enabling them to effectively express themselves and succeed in various academic and real-life situations.


