Composting and Basket Gardening Workshop Report 2022-23
A. Title of the Workshop/Activity: Composting and Basket Gardening Workshop
B. Background: The Department of Botany conducted a 'Hands-on training workshop on Composting and Basket Farming' for the stadents of Gotheghar Ashramshala. A session was held every Friday as per the school's convenience. By focusing on grammar, vocabulary, formal communication, confident speaking, and punctuation, the initiative sought to instill a strong foundation in language proficiency.
