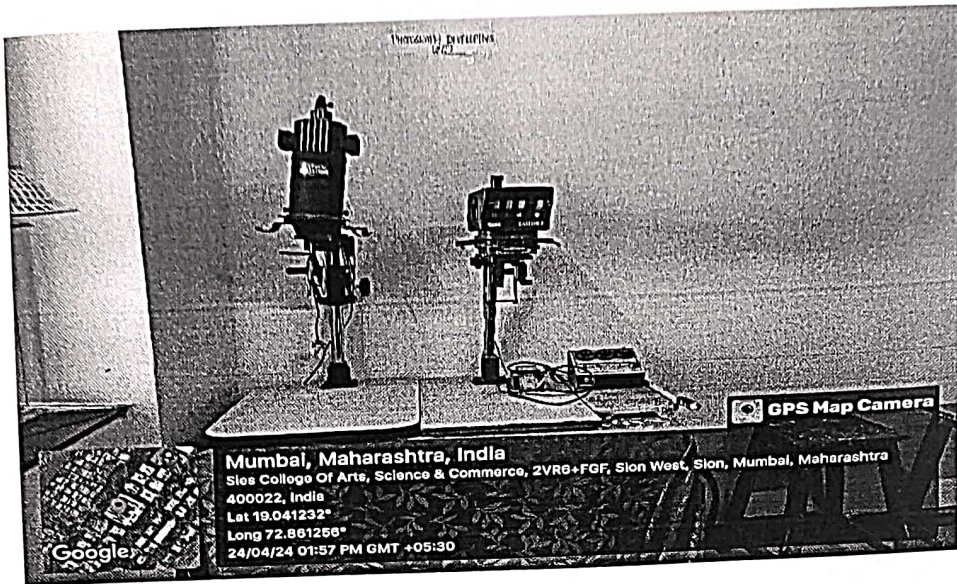

H. Outcome/Feedback:

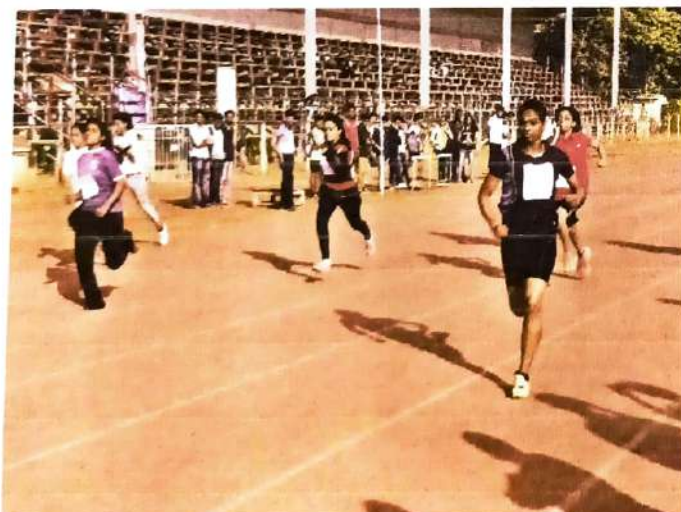

- Improved sportsmanship: The event emphasized fair play and good sportsmanship, leaving a positive impact on the participants.

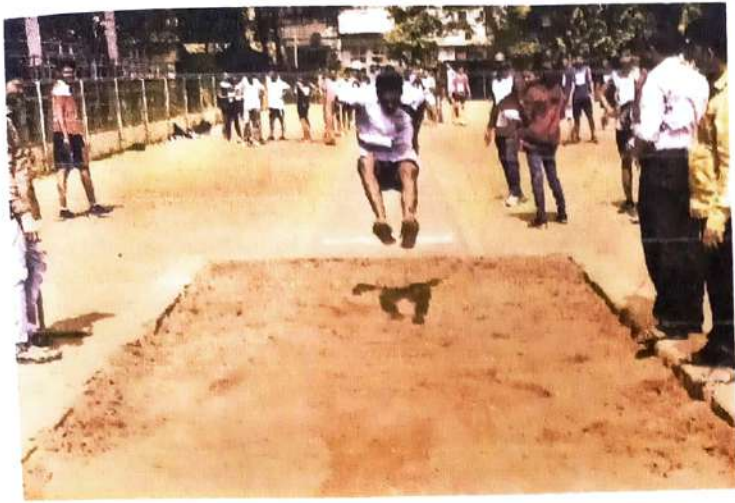
