### Outcomes of Extension and Outreach Activities (2025-2026)

The institution actively engages students in diverse extension and outreach activities through NSS, NCC, ISR Committees, and various departments. These activities are designed to promote experiential learning and holistic development. The student learning outcomes have been mapped using Bloom's Taxonomy to reflect cognitive, affective, and skill-based attainment.

#### A. Environmental Awareness and Sustainability Activities

Students participating in environmental initiatives demonstrated progressive learning outcomes ranging from understanding to creation.

1. Carried out 6 tree plantation drives and planted 108 trees
2. Performed 10 beaches clean-up and 2 mangroves clean up drives.
3. Performed 1 station clean up drive
4. Observed and explained environmental degradation issues such as marine pollution and mangrove ecosystem loss.
5. Participated in campaigns related to sustainable practices.

## **B. Health, Hygiene and Community Well-being Activities**

Students actively contributed to healthcare awareness and preventive health services in rural and urban communities.

1. Conducted 2 Free Health Check-up Camps for villagers at Vashind and analysed 58 samples.
2. 1 Personal Hygiene Awareness Programme for 98 primary and secondary Zilla Parishad School students, Vehloli.
3. Performed 2 Pulse Polio Immunization Drive with 1833 immunization.
4. Organised 1 Women Health Check-up Camp with 100 women beneficiaries in the college.
5. 42 NSS volunteers performed street play and rally on AIDS awareness.

## **C. Civic Engagement and Social Responsibility Activities**

Students demonstrated strong civic awareness and social responsibility through active participation in community services.

1. 17 volunteered in assisting senior citizens and voters by guiding them to their respective polling booth.
2. Demonstrated social commitment by contributing to 1 food distribution drive at Nair hospital.
3. Conducted 1 cloth collection drive and donated 145 clothing items underprivileged families.
4. Flood Relief Support in the form of grocery and stationary items for flood affected 115 students, Kharda, Marathwada. **This was acknowledge by JD, Higher Education, Pune**

## **D. Educational Outreach and Teaching-Learning Support Activities**

Students engaged in experiential teaching-learning processes to strengthen pedagogical and communication skills.

1. Organized 15 days teaching programme in association with Pratham foundation, NGO at 5 BMC Schools with more than 155 students.
2. Demonstrated 6 chemistry experiment based sessions for school students
3. 6 volunteers organized Colour Expression Activity for 55 school students at Vehloli.
4. Little Picassos – Creative Learning Initiative for 25 school students.

## **E. Awareness Generation and Cultural Engagement Activities**

Students contributed to awareness building and value-based education through creative expression and public engagement.

1. 84 volunteered through Rotaract and reached out to 5000 audience by Josh 10 – Cultural Awareness Programme.

2. 30 volunteered for creating scientific awareness by organizing Flora Fantasia Exhibition with 110 school students as beneficiaries from 5 schools around Sion.

#### **F. National Service and Defence Awareness Activities**

Students developed discipline, patriotism, and national integration values.

1. Performed 5 Blood Donation Drives and collected around 315 units.
2. Organized 1 Weapon Exhibition - Aabhishan by NCC unit
