A Natioanl Level Webinar on Intellectual Properity Rights

A National level Webinar on Intellectual property rights was conducted successfully by the SIES College of Arts,Science and Commerce[Autonomous] on **06-06-2020** jointly by The **IQAC and the Chemistry department** of the College via **Zoom digital platform**.Due to a huge response, the webinar was also **aired live on the college YouTube channel**.The registered participants were communicated about the detailed program schedule through a Telegram app group created by the organizing team for the event.The program began sharp at 11.00am with a brief welcome note by Dr.Laxmi.She apprised the audience of certain rules to adhere to so as to ensure smooth and effective conduct of the webinar.

This was followed by the Principal Dr. Uma Shankar's welcome address. She briefed the audience about the glorious background of SIES college, its contribution to society and nation building in the field of higher education during the 60 long years of its existence standing tall with its achievements as it entered its Diamond Jubilee this year. The resource person Dr. Idage, an eminent scientist,doctorate in polymer chemistry and recipient of three national awards reflected his profound knowledge on the topic and highlighted various IP rights-trademarks,patents,copyright etc,quasi -IP rights-trade secrets,confidential information etc with several case studies. He exhibited the procedures involved to apply for patents. He explained the requirements for patentability and how to write claims which triggered the young minds into thinking innovative ways. An interactive concourse ignited the inquisitiveness of the participants. The informative webinar culminated with a vote of thanks proposed by Prof. Shekhar from the Chemistry department.
