Report: A Health check- up camp was organized at Kawathewadi on 3rd April 2019 as a part of UGC extension activities. A team of DMLT students (22) along with teaching and non-teaching staff visited Kawathewadi and monitored Blood pressure, random sugar and haemoglobin estimation was carried. Around 51 villagers and their blood samples were tested, and we found that 80% villagers were found to be anaemic. Dr.Manju Phadke given a small talk on nutrition and diet to the villagers
