- A. Title of the Workshop/Activity: TWO CREDIT COURSE TITLED "INTRODUCTION TO ASTRONOMY"
- B. Background: The two-credit course titled "Basic Course in Astronomy" was designed and planned in association with Khagol Mandal, a non-profit that has been in engaged in Astronomy popularization in Maharashtra for the last 34 years.

As per the lecture plan which was distributed to the students at the beginning, lectures were to be held every Saturday from 3pm to 5pm. The first lecture was conducted on the 15th of November 2019 and the invited speaker was Dr Aniket Sule.

A total of 24 participants registered for the course. This included 20 students and 4 faculty members. Of the 20 students, 18 are eligible for the 2 credits allotted to the course.

A total of 15 lectures (14 Regular lectures and 1 Valedictory) with 31 Total contact hours were conducted. An overnight stargazing trip was arranged on the 20th of February 2020 that was the practical component of the course. The last lecture for the course was held on 29th February 2020.

The evaluation of the students was done on the basis of a 2/3 page lecture synopsis that were submitted by each student for every lecture. The synopsis was to include their understanding of the lecture with accompanying essential diagrams/images.

Some of the highlight lectures included a lecture on Cosmology and a lecture on Astrobiology. The valedictory function for the course will be held on the 10th of March 2020.

C. Aims/Objectives:

- To familiarize students to the field of astronomy and its relation with various fields of science viz. mathematics and biology.
- To understand concept of celestial objects and solar system.
- To attain the knowledge of evolution, classification, formation of stars.
- To learn the basic knowledge about cosmic threats.
