On receipt of the application the Syndicate appointed a Local Inquiry Committee consisting of the following members to report thereon :-

The report of the Local Inquiry Committee was considered by the Academic Council, and the Syndicate at their meetings held on 15th April, 1969 and 16th April, 1969, respectively.

The resolution of the Academic Council and the report of the Syndicate are as follows :-

Resolution of the Academic Council

It was resolved that it be reported to the Syndicate that, in the opinion of the Council, the affiliation of the South Indian Education Society's College of Arts and Science, Bombay, to the University, for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.A. (General and

Special) degree examination in English, Marathi, Gujarati, Hindi, Economics, Politics, Philosophy and Mathematics; the B.A. (General) degree examination in Sanskrit, French, German and History; the Intermediate Science examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and Physics, Chemistry and Biology and the B.Sc. degree examination in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (Principal and Subsidiary) and Botany and Zoology (Subsidiary) be made permanent with effect from 26th June, 1969.

Report of the Syndicate

The Syndicate, after considering the report of the Local Inquiry Committee and the resolution of the Academic Council thereon, report to the Senate that they are of the opinion that the affiliation of the South Indian Education Society's College of Arts and Science, Bombay, to the University, for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.A. (General and Special) degree examination in English, Marathi, Gujarati, Hindi, Economics, Politics, Philosophy and Mathematics; the B.A. (General) degree examination in Sanskrit, French, German and History; the Intermediate Science examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and Physics, Chemistry and Biology and the B.Sc. degree examination in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (Principal and Subsidiary) and Botany and Zoology (Subsidiary) be made permanent with effect from 20th June, 1969.

At their meeting held on 5th May, 1969, the Senate considered the above application together with the report of the Local Inquiry Committee, the resolution of the Academic Council thereon and the report of the Syndicate in the matter.

Professor G.C. Bannerjee moved, as recommended by the Syndicate and Professor T.A. Kasat seconded :-

"That the Senate approve of the report of the Syndicate in the matter of the permanent affiliation of the South Indian Education Society's College of Arts and Science, Bombay, and record their opinion that the affiliation of the college to the University, for the teaching of the courses of study leading to the B.A. (General and Special) degree examination in English, Marathi, Gujarati, Hindi, Economics, Politics, Philosophy and Mathematics; the B.A. (General) degree examination in Sanskrit, French, German and History; the Intermediate Science examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and Physics, Chemistry and Biology and the B.Sc. degree examination in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (Principal and Subsidiary) and Botany and Zoology (Subsidiary) be made permanent with effect from 20th June, 1969."

The motion was put to the vote and carried.

Gentlemen,

This University had recommended to Government for its approval, applications of following 14 Arts and Science Colleges for addition of Commerce Faculty i.e. for extension of affiliation for teaching the courses of study leading to the B.Com. degree examination from the academic year commencing from June, 1980.

- 2) Sir Sitaram & Lady Shantabai Patkar College, Goregaon.
- 3) Jai Hind College, Churchgate.
- 4) Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College, Ghatkopar.
- 5) D.G. Ruparel College, Matunga.
- 6) Maharashtra College of Arts & Science, Byculla.
- 7) Khalsa College, Matunga.
- 8) Maharshi Dayanand College, Parel.
- 9) Hazarimal Somani College of Arts & Science, Chowpatty.
- 10) Seth L.U. Jhaveri College of Arts & Sir M.V. College of Science, Andheri.
- 11) Siddharth College of Arts & Science, Fort.
- 12) S.I.E.S. College, Sion.
- 13) Mithibai College of Arts & Chauhan Institute of Science, Vile Parle.
- 14) M.M. College of Arts & M.M. Institute of Science, Andheri.

The office received a letter bearing No. NGC 3580/5346/XXV, dated 16th May, 1980 from the Under Secretary to Government, Education & Employment Department communicating to the University approval of the State Government under Section 43 (4 and 5) of the Bombay University Act, 1974 for further processing their applications. The permission has been granted subject to the following conditions :-

- i) The College will have two divisions each of 100 students.
- ii) The College must have minimum enrolment of 40 students in each Faculty in which it has been permitted to impart instruction for the First Year of the degree course.
- iii) Not less than 30 students should appear for the University examinations held at the end of the academic year 1980-81.

At the Executive Council's meeting held on 24th May, 1980 the Vice-Chancellor informed the Council of the receipt of the abovementioned letter and its contents.

M-

The Executive Council resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to appoint a committee to make local inquiries and reports on the applications of the abovementioned colleges. The Council further resolved that in view of the fact that permission from the Government to process the applications of colleges is received late, pending visits of the local inquiry committee, the colleges be permitted to go ahead in making preparations for starting the course and admitting students to the First Year B.Com. class from June, 1980, subject to their giving an undertaking in writing :-

- 1) that they will not admit students in more than two divisions each of 100 students,
- 2) that they will incur expenditure on purchase of books and journals as may be recommended by the local inquiry committee,
- 3) that they will appoint necessary staff for teaching First Year B.Com. course as may be recommended by the local inquiry committee,
- 4) that the opening of the Commerce Faculty will not adversely affect the admissions of students of the College in Arts and Science Faculties.

I am writing this to inform you that the Vice-Chancellor has appointed you as members of a committee to make local inquiries and reports on the applications of the abovementioned colleges. I am accordingly to request you kindly to form yourselves into a committee and to do the needful.


I am sending herewith a copy each of the applications of the abovementioned colleges. The following other papers are also enclosed for information.

 - ii) The applications received from the colleges for addition of Commerce/Science faculties i.e. for extension of affiliation for teaching B.Com./B.Sc. degree courses from 1980-81

and to make recommendations to the Council as to (a) the names of Societies whose applications for affiliation of new colleges from the academic year 1980-81 be considered and (b) the names of colleges whose applications for addition of Commerce/Science faculty be considered.

I shall be obliged if you kindly fix early dates and timings for your Committee's visits to the abovementioned 14 colleges and let me know the same to enable me to inform the Principals of the respective colleges.




"It is further recommended that the College be permitted to have two Divisions of F.Y.B.Com. class on permanent basis."

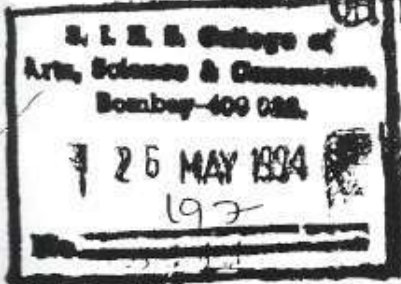

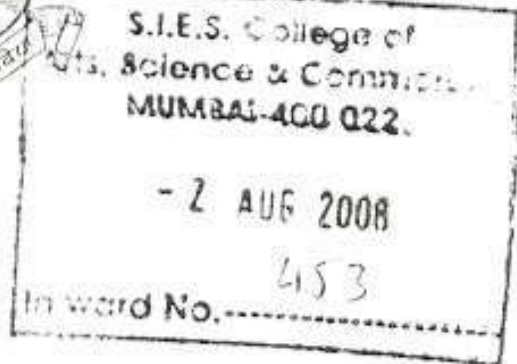

The increase in seats sought by the College from 5 to 10 each in the branches of Organic Chemistry and Inorganic Chemistry from 1994-95 is recommended subject to the conditions laid down below from the academic year 1994-95 onwards.
