Notice & Standard Operating Procedure for SEAT (SIES Education Assistance Trust) SCHOLARSHIP
(Applicable only for Self-Financed/Unaided Courses)
Junior College (FYJC, SYJC) and Degree College (Only for Undergraduate courses)

1. Students are eligible to apply for the above scholarship, only if their annual family income is Rs.3,00,000/- or less, and moreover, they should have scored 70% percentage of marks and above in the previous year examination (without repeated attempts or supplementary exams or without ATKT).
2. Eligible students should download and take print out of the SEAT Scholarship Application form (SEAT Scholarship Application form is uploaded on college website <https://siesascs.edu.in/> along with this notice),
3. Eligible students should read the instructions given in the SEAT Scholarship Application form and fill the required details.
4. Eligible students are also required to fill and submit a google form in addition to SEAT Scholarship Application form. The link for the google form is given below:

5. Eligible students will submit the hardcopy/printout of the SEAT Scholarship Application Form along with supporting documents (please check the list given below the table) on or before 16th August 2026, to the respective Teacher Incharge, as given in the following table. They can also contact these teachers for any further doubts/queries regarding the scholarship.
