

## **Admission to MSc Part – I programme for Academic year 2026-27**

### **MSc BOTANY**

The students applying for admission to the MSc Botany in our college are hereby informed, that they will be enrolling for two years Postgraduate programme, having the pattern/scheme given under National Education Policy (NEP).

#### **Eligibility:**

1. BSc with Botany (For NEP Batch)
2. BSc with 6 Units or 3 Units of Botany (For Pre-NEP Batch)

#### **Instructions and Details of Admission to MSc Part I Botany**

1. The Department of Botany offers the student, a choice between two electives for M.Sc Programme in the subject of Botany; (Elective 1: Environmental Botany; Elective 2: Cytogenetics and Plant Biotechnology); whereby, the student will be given any one elective based on merit.
2. **No Entrance Test** will be conducted for admission to M.Sc. Programme in the subject of Botany.
3. The selection of students for M.Sc. Programme in the subject of Botany will be based on merit decided on the basis of TYBSc Semester V marks.
4. The student should have passed TYBSc Semester VI exam, and the student should not have any ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) during confirmation of admission to M.Sc. programme.
5. The student should not have any pending ATKTs (Allowed to Keep Terms) from earlier Semesters (I, II, III, IV).
6. The student having academic gap (student who has done graduation/TYBSc earlier than academic year 2025-26) is required to submit a gap certificate/affidavit at the time of submission of application form.
7. Students should note that all admissions are strictly provisional until students comply with the eligibility criteria and verification of documents
8. The total number of seats available for M.Sc. Programme in the subject of Botany are 10 (ten).
9. The student/parents are welcome to visit the Department of Botany, so that, they can meet and interact with the faculty and see the laboratory facilities/infrastructure in the Department of Botany.
