





Methadology:

- The program was conducted using online platform zoom, through power point presentations.
- Mr. Bhavesh Kothari an entrepreseur and a startup mentor guided be students on developing a startup business idea. Mr. Kothari gave insights on the process of incubating an idea and toola required to make it viable and profitable. Further, two start-up initiatives were put forth by Mr. Yish Hajare and Mr. Vignesh Reddy. Mr Hajare presented his UV-C sanitization box by STEM Learning that disinfects not just mobile phones, wallets, keys, cash, masks, worches, shoes, but vegetables, medical equipment and laptops too. The box is currently available on anazon.in. Mr. Reddy presented 'FLOODWATCH', a community centric, real-time warning system for floods.

Outcome:

Two students Yash Hapne and Vignesh Reddy presented their projects which was well received by the students,





Fig 2 - Mr. Blurresh Kothari's Prosentation




Fig 4 - Mr. Vignesh Roddys's Presentation
