A ballad is a song that tells a story

It is a form of narrative poetry

It was originally written to accompany dance

Origin: Late Middle Ages

General Rhyme Scheme: abcb

Characteristics




Ballad Singer:

- Is dramatic
- Is impersonal; makes no personal reference
- Uses action and dialogue

Ballad:

- Has stock phrases
- Has a refrain
- Has incremental repetition
