



Internshala Trainings College Registration Agreement

This **Agreement** is executed on 22.06.2020 by and between:

Scholiverse Educare Private Limited (company registration number- U80901HR2011PTC064443), herein after referred to as Internshala which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to include its executors, representatives and permitted assigns, having its registered office at Block-B, 6th Floor, Unit No. 610, Unitech Business Zone, South City-2, Gurugram, Haryana, India - 122018, acting through its Authorized Representative Mr. Sarvesh Agrawal;

AND

SIES College of Arts, Science and Commerce (hereinafter referred to as the "College" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to include its executors, representatives and permitted assigns) situated at Jain Society, Sion West, Mumbai 400022, ;acting through its Authorized Representative Ms. Mahalaxmi Nadar

Internshala and College may be referred to as 'Party' individually and as 'Parties' collectively, as the context may require.

1. Overview

This Agreement is regarding skill building of students of College through online trainings provided by Internshala Trainings (https://trainings.internshala.com) – e-learning platform of Internshala.

2. Agreement Term

This Agreement will be operational and valid for the period of 3 years from the date of execution (i.e. from 22nd June 2020 to 21st June 2023, hereinafter referred to as Term) or until the date of earlier termination. Upon completion of the Term, the Agreement can be renewed with mutual consent of both Parties.

3. Internshala Deliverables

- I. Internshala will make the online trainings available to all the students of the college at a specially reduced fee (please see annexure A) that students will pay individually.
- II. Post payment of the fee, the students will be given access to their chosen training on Internshala Trainings.
- III. Other than learning material that consists of structured video tutorials, exercises, and tests; the enrolled students will be given access to a doubt clearing forum to clarify their doubts online with the trainers
- IV. In case students are not able to complete their training in stipulated time due to a valid reason, Internshala will extend the training duration for such students so as to enable them to complete their training.
- V. Upon completion of the training, students will be provided with a **certificate of Training** after they appear for the final online exam and score minimum 33% marks in it.







- VI. Post completion of the training, Internshala will provide placement assistance to all the enrolled students which will consist of following
 - a. Free access to an online Placement Preparation Training covering resume writing, cover letter writing, application process, and interview preparation
 - b. Access to curated jobs and internships as per students' preference that they can apply to online
 - c. Top performing students of the training will be highlighted in their job/internship applications on Internshala
- VII. Internshala will provide regular updates to College abouts its students performance in the enrolled online trainings as per College's request
- VIII. Post signing of the Agreement, Internshala will inform the students of College registered with it about the benefits available to them under the Agreement at regular intervals.

4. College Deliverables

I. Inform the students of College about the Agreement and the benefits available to them under it at regular intervals through various means such as written notice, email, WhatsApp, intranet etc.

5. Branding

- I. Internshala grants College a limited, non-exclusive, non-sub-licensable, non-transferable, non-assignable (except in conjunction with a permitted assignment of this Agreement) license during the Term to use Internshala Trainings name and logo as 'Official Training Partner' in College's internal and external communications as College deems fit. Use of Internshala Trainings name and logo by College will adhere to the brand guidelines of Internshala.
- II. College grants Internshala a limited, non-exclusive, non-sub-licensable, non-transferable, non-assignable (except in conjunction with a permitted assignment of this Agreement) license during the Term to use College name and logo in internal and external communications as Internshala deems fit.
- III. Except to the limited extent expressly provided in this Agreement, neither Party grants, nor the other Party will not acquire, any right, title or interest (including, without limitation, any implied license) in or to any property of the first Party. All rights not expressly granted herein are deemed withheld. All use by a Party of the other trade names, trademarks, service marks, logos, etc., and any goodwill associated therewith, will inure to the benefit of the grantor.

6. Termination

In case of either Party wanting to terminate the Agreement, it can be done on a mutually agreed upon date in a justified way with a notification given at least 30 days prior to termination date. However, the Parties will ensure that interests of the students who may have already enrolled for future batches or currently undergoing the training on Internshala Trainings at the time of termination or expiration of this Agreement are not impacted and they are provided with necessary services and support as promised to them at the time of enrollment.







7. Confidentiality

- I. Internshala and College will not disclose the details of this Agreement and any private information that they come across when this Agreement is in effect to any third-Party.
- II. If either Party (the "Receiving Party") under this Agreement gains access to confidential information of the other Party (the "Disclosing Party") concerning the Disclosing Party's prices, business, plans, technology, products, and other non-public information of the Disclosing Party (collectively, "CI" or "Confidential Information"), then the terms of this section will apply. CI includes all information in tangible or intangible form that is marked or designated as confidential by the Disclosing Party or that, under the circumstances of its disclosure, should be considered confidential. The Disclosing Party owns all right, title and interest, including all patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret rights and any other intellectual property or proprietary rights in any jurisdiction, including any and all applications, renewals, extensions and restorations thereof, in the Disclosing Party's CI. Each Party agrees that it will not use in any way, for its own benefit or the benefit of any third Party, except as expressly permitted by, or as required to implement, this Agreement, nor disclose to any third Party (except as required by law or to such Party's attorneys, accountants and other advisors as reasonably necessary), any of the Disclosing Party's CI. Each Party will take reasonable precautions to protect the confidentiality of the other Party's CI that are at least as stringent as it takes to protect its own CI.

8. Force Majeure

Neither Party will be liable to the other for failure to fulfill obligations hereunder if such failure is due to causes beyond its control, including, without limitation, acts of God, earthquake, fire, flood, embargo, catastrophe, sabotage, utility or transmission failures, governmental prohibitions or regulations, national emergencies, insurrections, riots or wars, strikes, work stoppages or other labor difficulties ("Force Majeure Event"). The time for any performance required hereunder will be extended by the delay incurred as a result of such Force Majeure Event.

9. Disputes

The Parties shall attempt in good faith to resolve any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement promptly by negotiation between executives. Any dispute arising out of, in connection with or relating to this Agreement, or the breach, termination or validity thereof, that has not been resolved by negotiation with-in thirty (30) calendar days after a Party's request for negotiation, would be resolved by arbitration. Should arbitration fail, the dispute shall be resolved under the jurisdiction of Gurgaon court.

(First party and Second party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'party')


WHERE AS:

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- Both Parties are united by common interest and objectives, and they shall
 establish channel of communication and co-operation that will promote and
 advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
 The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall
 share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for
 one another.
- First and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.
- 3. The general terms of the co-operations shall be governed by this MOU. The parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreement, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The terms of Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subjects matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU.

- The budding graduates from the institution could play key role in the technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/ training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 3. Industrial Training and Visits: Industry visit and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its member companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide Labs/Workshops/Industrial sites for the hands-on training of the learner enrolled with the First Party.
- 4. **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out joint research activities in the fields of Food Technology, nutraceuticals and related areas.
- Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standard in concerned sector, if available.



8. **Activities Under This Agreement** – It is expected that activities taking place under this agreement will be initiated primarily in coordination with their respective administrative units concerned with such activities. All activities undertaken must conform to the policies and procedures in place at each institution.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permission and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.

- 9. Planning and Management of Activities Each distinct collaboration program or activity will be described in separate 'Activity Agreement' drawn up jointly by the collaborating units, and signed by the heads of these units. Such agreements will specify the names of those individuals on each institution responsible for the implementation of the program.
- 10. Funding of Activities There is no financial commitment on the part of the SIESASC, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately. Activity Agreement should make financial costs and obligations explicit. Collaborating units are encouraged to work together to identify and secure any outside funding which may be needed. Projects requiring funding must be approved by both institutions.
- Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to facilitate and help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/Jobs.
- 12. Limitation and Warranties: Each party shall ensure that the other is not put to any liability for any act of the respective party under this MOU. Each Party represents that they have full power and authority to enter into this MOU in general.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

- Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or
 otherwise create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the
 intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents,
 copy rights and designs) of the other party.
- 2. Both the Parties may receive information proprietary to other Party (the "Confidential Information") in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the Parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either Parties possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the Parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust, to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 3. Both the Parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other Party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, title and interest therein.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY:

 This agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on the mutually agreed terms.



- 2. Either Party may terminate this MOU by providing 60 days advance written notice to the other party. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 3. Modification The terms of this Agreement may be changed or modified only by written amendment signed by authorized agents of the Parties hereto.

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

- 1. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership.
- 2. Either Party shall not use the name and brand of the other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- 3. Any and all disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with this MOU or its performance shall, so far as it is possible, be settled by negotiations between the Parties amicably through consultation & understanding.
- 4. Either Party shall indemnify and hold each other harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees.





- D. First party and Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each other's resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- E. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on co-operation within area of Skill-based Training, Education and Research
- F. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

Introduction of organizations involved

PRATHAM MUMBAI EDUCATION INITIATIVE (PMEI)

Pratham started in Mumbai in 1994 with the vision and mission of "Every Child in School and Learning Well". In the early years, Pratham's area of work was Mumbai; now it is spread across India. Initially, Pratham catered exclusively to children in urban areas, but now works on a large scale in rural areas across India. From being a service delivery organization, Pratham has evolved to be an innovator of methods of large-scale delivery. To support the growth and needs of the rural and urban programs, the continuous development of teaching-learning approaches, methods and materials as well as training are continuous ongoing activities.

PRATHAM COUNCIL FOR VULNERABLE CHILDREN (PCVC)

Pratham Council for Vulnerable Children (PCVC) serves as the Child Rights and Protection wing of Pratham, established in the year 2000, with the aim of "Every Child's Rights Protected, Every Child in School and Learning Well."
