

- A. Title of the Workshop/Activity: Kalpavriksha (Departmental Festival) 2023-2024
- **B.** Background: Department of Botany organized celebration of Departmental festival 'Kalpavriksha' on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024. It was held offline in Biology laboratory 1 & 2 including the corridor area outside the labs from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm. The event was sponsored by Zoot Digital and Biren Daftary Biology. Total number of student volunteers was 49 from F. Y. B. Sc., S. Y. B. Sc. and T. Y. B. Sc. Different types of floral art-works such as pendants, keychains, coconut planters, seed bombs, etc. were created by the student volunteers and exhibited for sale. The other stall comprised of delicious cakes and drinks such as Edible Terraria, Cyano-Squash (Lemon Squash) prepared by the volunteers and served fresh at reasonable rates. All the stalls received overwhelming responses from the visitors and all appreciated the unique creations prepared by the students. The total earnings / profit from the stall sale was approximately Rs. 7000/-.
